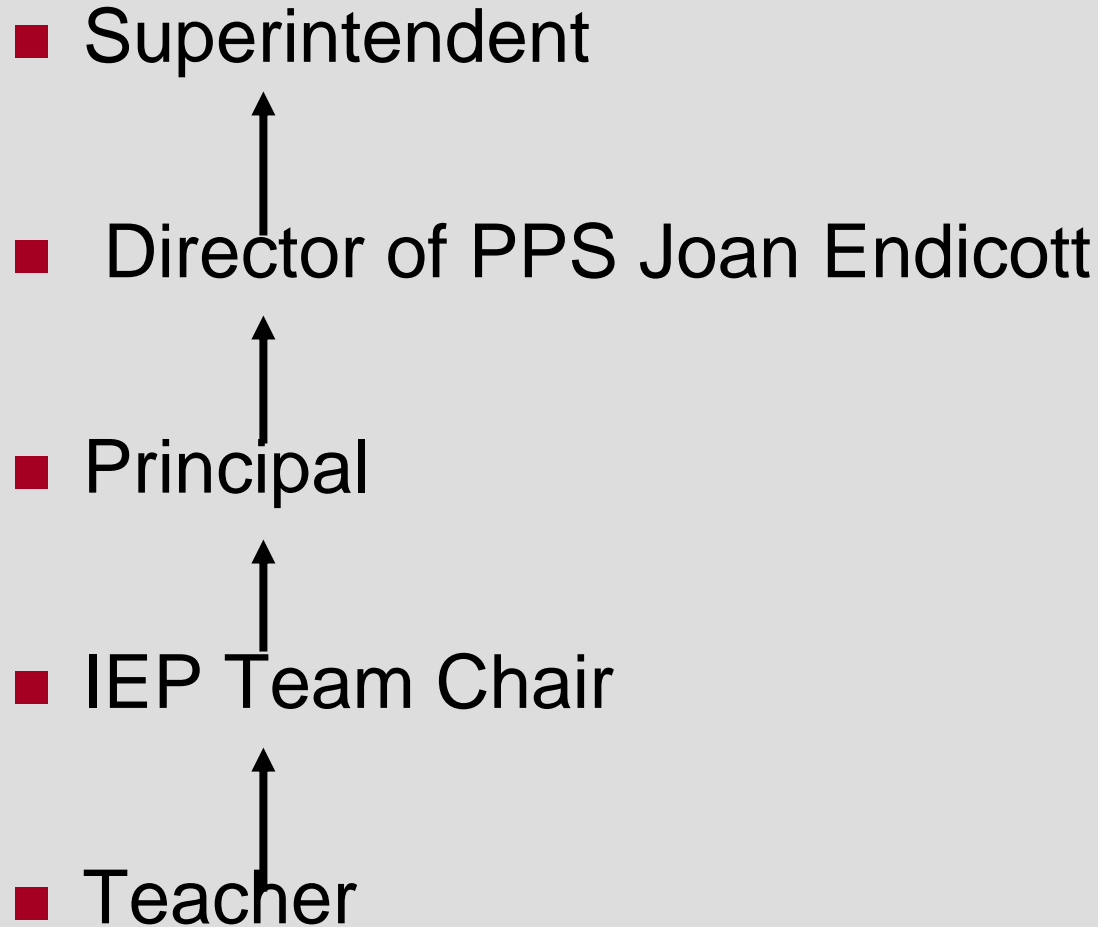

 - 1) Call to set up an appointment. The Groton-Dunstable High School telephone number is (978) 448-6362.
 - 2) If the coach cannot be reached call the Athletic Director, Mr. Dan Twomey. He will set up a meeting for you.

- What A Parent Can Do If the Meeting With The Coach Did Not Provide A Satisfactory Resolution
 - 1) Call and set up an appointment with the Athletic Director to discuss the situation.
 - 2) At this meeting the appropriate next step can be determined.
