I started working in my mother's preschool in 1980, and have worked with the birth to three population in Early Intervention programs from 1989 to 1999. As well as providing individual therapies for children and families, I helped create group curricula over the years, and would like to share some of these experiences and ideas with you and your child. I want to help make your child's early group play experience a positive one.

Group Schedule: Each day, the playgroup will follow a loose schedule, but the interests of children and parents take precedence. If the children want to stick with a particular activity, then I plan to follow their lead.

Developmentally appropriate activities will be offered. Some activities may be repeated from week to week, and some will be presented only once or twice, based on the weekly theme. A lot, however, will depend on the interests of the children.
