FOR: Groton-Dunstable Middle School students supervised by adults/parents

WHEN: 2:30 – 5:00 on Tuesdays for 7 weeks starting Oct. 27 and ending Dec. 15 (no bowling on Nov 24)

CHOICE: Students can bowl just for fun or be organized into teams for competitive play. Instruction on scoring and basic bowling technique will be available.

HOW: Students will board a hired bus at the Middle School dismissal time and be transported to Harvard Lanes. The bus will return students to the Middle School parking lot at 5:00 for parent/guardian pick up.

- Attendance will be taken before the bus leaves school. If a student is missing, the Coordinator will inform the parent/guardian by calling the phone numbers provided on the student's Enrollment Form.
- Students should be picked up promptly at 5:00 in the Middle School parking lot. A late fee of \$5.00 per 15 minutes is charged after 5:00. Students may not re-enter the Middle School.
- If a student will be absent from School, besides calling the office, parents must also call the bowling Coordinator at (978) 448-6714
- Any student being picked up at Harvard Lanes must check out with an adult supervisor before leaving.

SNACK:

- bring a snack from home
- purchase from the vending machines at Harvard lanes(candy/soda)
- purchase from the "snack box" which will provide healthier pre-packaged items each for \$1.00 (juice, water, granola bars, pretzels, etc.)

COST: \$154.00 per student for the 7 weeks session (20% sibling discount)
